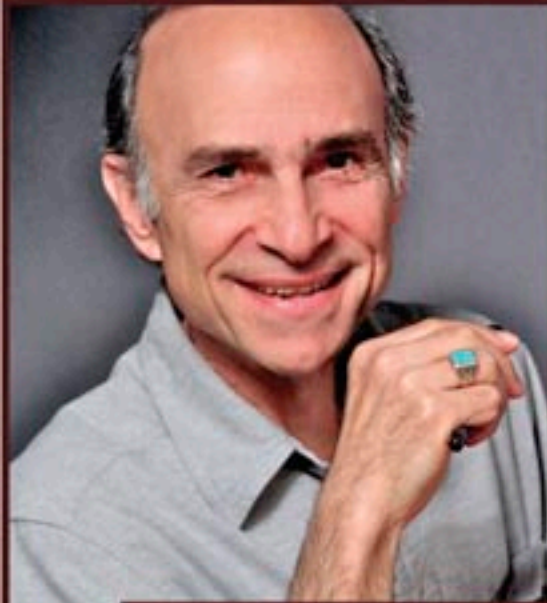

Called by Lawrence Ferlinghetti "certainly the best poetry critic in sight" for his previous collection of essays, *Moving Targets*, Stephen Kessler—poet, translator, novelist and editor—has written insightfully as a journalist on whatever has inspired his enthusiasm or aroused his curiosity. *The Tolstoy of the Zulus* gathers a generous selection of his writings since the late 1970s on cultural, artistic and literary subjects including Saul Bellow, Bob Dylan, Harry Belafonte, Charles Bukowski, Luis Buñuel, Romare Bearden, Edward Hopper, Henry Miller, Thelonious Monk and many others, both famed and lesser known. Kessler is the editor of the award-winning literary newspaper *The Redwood Coast Review* and the recipient of a National Endowment for the Arts Fellowship, a Lambda Literary Award and the Harold Morton Landon Translation Award from the Academy of American Poets.
